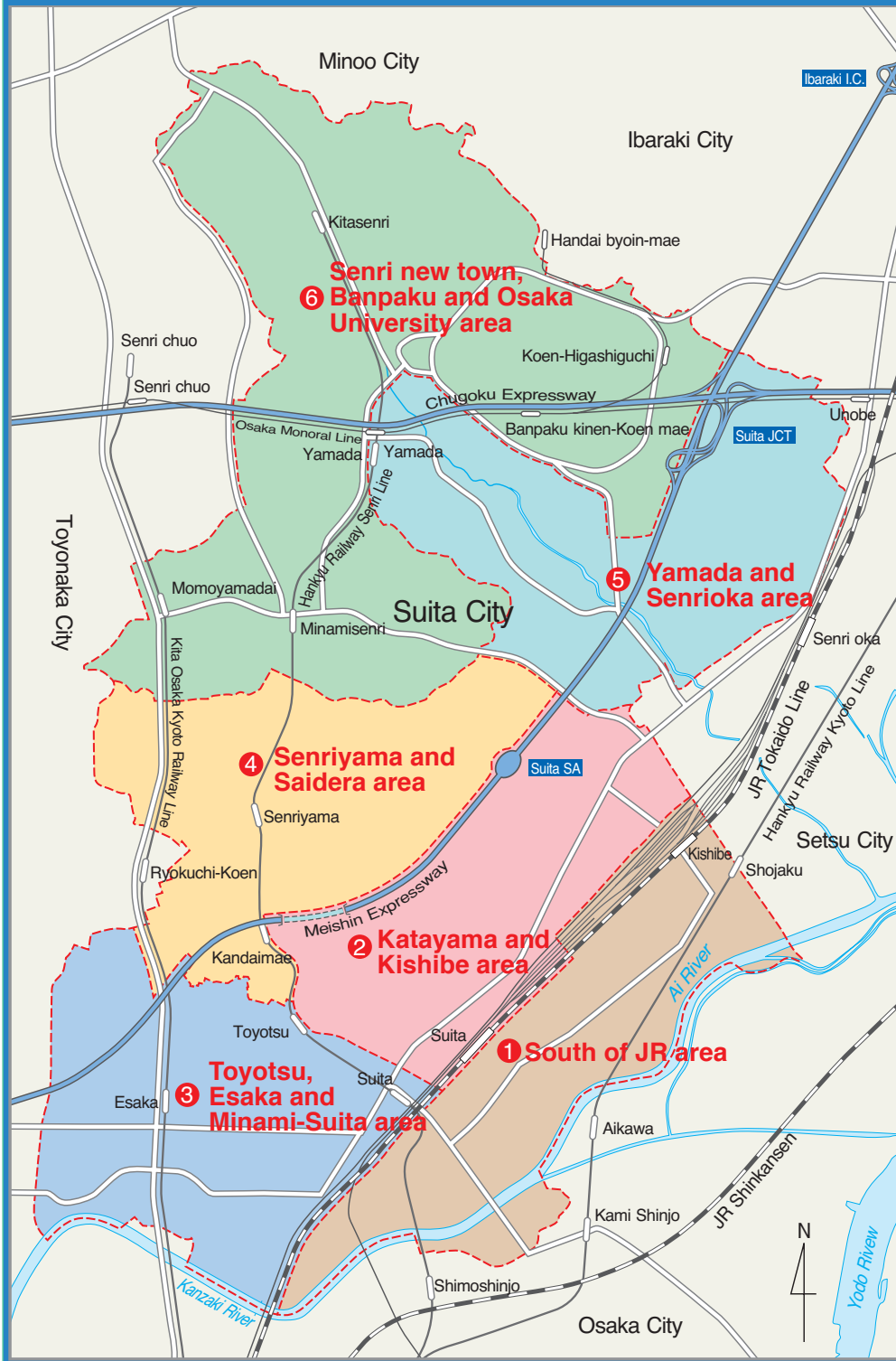


# Disaster Prevention Map

### 一時避難地 Temporary evacuation site

This is a site to which people make a voluntary evacuation for the prevention of secondary disaster such as after shock. An open area approximately 1ha (approx. 10,000m<sup>2</sup>) or larger

### 広域避難地 Wider-area evacuation site

This is a site to which people evacuate according to directions provided by the municipal employees, police officers, and/or fire crews if potential risk of the spreading fire is present. An open area approximately 10ha (approx. 100,000m<sup>2</sup>) or larger

### 避難所 Refuges

This is a facility that will be opened to those who lost their houses and are enmeshed in difficulties in living in their houses due to terrible conditions in the event of a disaster. Information service regarding the disaster is available at the refuges, and the refuges will provide citizens with opportunities to voice their wants and needs. Emergency goods such as drinking water, food and blankets will be provided.

### 福祉避難所 Welfare Refuge

This is a special refuge for the elderly, disabled, or other evacuees who require special care or consideration while living at a standard refuge.

### 医療救護所 First-aid station

This is a first-aid station that will be set up to administer medical aid to those who are injured from the disaster if the municipal medical institutions can not accommodate them.

### 災害時給水拠点 Water supply stations in times of disaster

When water has stopped because of a disaster such as an earthquake, potable tap water from water purification plants and water distribution plants will be provided to residents at these locations.
